The MH8 has four settings; low, medium, high and boost, as well as a blink light setting and coloured light option. The unit is simple to use and operates well in all the circumstances required. You can set it on low for around camp or on full beam in the field for distances of up to 200 metres.

The beam can be adjusted by twisting a rotating lense, taking it from a wide-angle light to a strong straight beam.

The MH8 has a very efficient battery life and offers two options; rechargeable 3.7V lithium ion battery or 2 x AA batteries. The battery compartment is on the front, unlike most other models, and was easy to adapt to.

With three straps over your head; two on the sides and one on the top, the MH8 is very sturdy and easy to adjust to fit an individual's head.

The actual light unit itself can also be removed from the straps if needed, to make it easier to change batteries or to sit on a flat surface as a lamp.

My favourite feature was the ON button. Have you ever arrived into camp after a good slog only to find your headlamp has turned itself on and drained the battery.
